We celebrate the Lord's Supper today! Please prepare yourselves using these questions as a guide:


- Have I been baptized in the Name of the Triune God, Father, Son & Holy Spirit?
- Do I believe that I am a sinful being without hope for eternal life except in mercy of Jesus Christ?
- Do I believe in Jesus as My Savior?
- Do I believe that Jesus Christ is personally present in communion with His body and blood to forgive my sins, as the Bible teaches?
- Do I desire and strive by the power of the Holy Spirit to live a God-pleasing life?

As you come to the Lord's Supper you are affirming with each communicant that Jesus is your Lord and Savior, and that the Lutheran Church's confession of Jesus Christ and His Supper is your confession as well.

Prelude

Please note that in the hymnal whenever we see a small triangle next to a hymn verse, that triangle means the Trinity is proclaimed in that verse and we are to stand for that verse.



The Invocation and Confession

Pastor: In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit.

People: This is God's name, the name placed upon us in Holy Baptism

Pastor: This Sunday we ponder the mysteries of God, one God yet three persons.

People: We know the Holy Trinity as God has revealed himself,

Pastor as Father, Son, and Spirit

People: May the grace of the Lord Jesus Christ, and the love of God, and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit

be with you all. (2 Corinthians 13:14)

Pastor: Even in Genesis chapter 1, God says, "Let us...."

People: In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. He was

with God in the beginning. Through Him all things were made; without Him nothing was made

that has been made. (John 1:1-4)

Pastor: In Jesus we know and see the Father.

People: Jesus answered, "I am the way the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except

through me. If you really knew me, you would know my Father as well. From now on, you do

know Him and have seen Him." (John 14:6-7)

Pastor: Jesus frequently used the name "I Am".

People: "I tell you the truth," Jesus answered, "before Abraham was born, I Am! (John 8:58)

Pastor: This week we ponder in wonder the mystery of one God, yet three persons.

People: Jesus said, "I and the Father are one." (John 10:30)

People: Amen. (Please be seated)

The First Reading – Genesis 1:1-5, 26-28 (God Creates)

- ¹ In the beginning, God created the heavens and the earth.
- ² The earth was without form and void, and darkness was over the face of the deep. And the Spirit of God was hovering over the face of the waters.
 - ³ And God said, "Let there be light," and there was light.
 - ⁴ And God saw that the light was good. And God separated the light from the darkness.
- ⁵ God called the light Day, and the darkness he called Night. And there was evening and there was morning, the first day.

²⁶Then God said, "Let us make man in our image, after our likeness. And let them have dominion over the fish of the sea and over the birds of the heavens and over the livestock and over all the earth and over every creeping thing that creeps on the earth."

²⁷ So God created man in his own image, in the image of God he created him; male and female he created them.

²⁸ And God blessed them. And God said to them, "Be fruitful and multiply and fill the earth and subdue it, and have dominion over the fish of the sea and over the birds of the heavens and over every living thing that moves on the earth."

Epistle: Romans 8:12-17 (The Spirit testifies in our heart as to who we are)

¹² So then, brothers, we are debtors, not to the flesh, to live according to the flesh.

¹³ For if you live according to the flesh you will die, but if by the Spirit you put to death the deeds of the body, you will live.

¹⁴ For all who are led by the Spirit of God are sons of God.

¹⁵ For you did not receive the spirit of slavery to fall back into fear, but you have received the Spirit of adoption as sons, by whom we cry, "Abba! Father!"

¹⁶ The Spirit himself bears witness with our spirit that we are children of God, ¹⁷ and if children, then heirs—heirs of God and fellow heirs with Christ, provided we suffer with him in order that we may also be glorified with him.

People: Thanks be to God.

The Gospel

Pastor: The Holy Gospel is written in the 28th chapter of St. Matthew beginning at the 16th verse. (God's people are baptized into the name of the one Triune God.)

People: Glory be to Thee, O Lord.

¹⁶ Now the eleven disciples went to Galilee, to the mountain to which Jesus had directed them.

¹⁷ And when they saw him they worshiped him, but some doubted.

¹⁸ And Jesus came and said to them, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me.

¹⁹ Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, ²⁰ teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age."

Pastor: This is the Gospel of our Lord.

People: Praise be to Thee, O Christ.

The Nicene Creed

All: I believe in one God, the Father Almighty, maker of heaven and earth and of all things visible and invisible and in one Lord Jesus Christ, the only-begotten Son of God, begotten of His Father before all worlds, God of God, Light of Light, very God of very God, begotten not made, being of one substance with the Father, by whom all things were made; who for us men and for our salvation came down from heaven and was incarnate by the Holy Spirit of the Virgin Mary and was made man; and was crucified also for us under Pontius Pilate. He suffered and was buried; and the third day He rose again according to the Scriptures; and ascended into heaven and sits on the right hand of the Father; and He will come again with glory, to judge both the living and the dead; whose Kingdom shall have no end. I believe in the Holy Spirit, the Lord and Giver of Life, who proceeds from the Father and the Son, who with the Father and the Son together is worshiped and glorified, who spoke by the Prophets. And I believe in one holy Christian and Apostolic Church. I acknowledge one baptism for the remission of sins, and I look for the resurrection of the dead, and the life of the world to come. Amen.


Pastor: Let us give thanks unto the Lord, our God.

The Words of Institution


Pastor:


