

NEW SCHOOL CAPITAL CAMPAIGN

Our church is blessed with a growing and thriving school ministry that serves over 260⁺ students from preschool to eighth grade. Our school provides a Christ-centered education that prepares our students for academic excellence, spiritual growth, and service to God and others.

However, our current facilities are no longer adequate to meet the needs and demands of our school. Therefore, on 14 August the congregation approved a bold and visionary plan to build a new elementary school.

To make this vision a reality, we need your help and support. We are launching a Capital Campaign to raise funds from our supporters that can be used in lieu of a portion of a loan, down payment, or collateral for a loan. Either of these will reduce the interest rate and monthly payments of the loan. It can also demonstrate our financial viability and commitment to the potential lender. Our goal is to raise \$1 million by 1 May 2024 through pledges, donations, grants, events, and other sources.

To begin this effort, we invite you to attend a Capital Campaign Brainstorming Session on Thursday, 31 August from 6:30-8:00 PM in the Youth Room. This session will: communicate campaign goals and plans; solicit feedback and input for the campaign; identify action items; and recruit volunteers and leaders.
